Official Rules

- **Chili entries may be any home cooked recipe. Beans are permitted.**
- **Entrants must be present Friday, February 7th in the Pinetree MPR**
- **Chili must arrive on the Pinetree campus ready to serve by 5:45 p.m.**
- **Each contestant must prepare a minimum of four (4) quarts of chili to be served in 2 ounce portions. The attendees are your judges, so the more portions you serve the more opportunity to win votes.**
- **Contestants must provide a list of all ingredients in their recipes so any attendees with food allergies can make informed selections.**
- **Pinetree PTA will provide bowls/cups, spoons, napkins, rolls, salad and drinks.**
- **Contestants may add toppings (cheese, onions, sour cream, etc) to their chili servings as part of their recipe. No toppings will be provided by Pinetree PTA.**
- **Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own serving utensils and their own heating source (no open flames) to keep their entry at proper serving temperature.**
- **Electricity will be available for crock pots.**
- **Event attendees will be the judges. Each attendee will receive a token to vote for their favorite chili. The contestant who has received the most tokens when votes are tallied at 7:30 p.m. will be awarded the grand prize.**
- **All results are final.**
